

Xerox Silver Nanoparticle Ultrasonic Aerosol Jet Ink Product Code: xcm-nsUA

Xerox silver nanoparticle ink is based on proprietary silver nanoparticles designed and created at the Xerox Research Centre of Canada.

Technology

- Low annealing temperature (120 °C) enabled by small and uniform particles (8 nm ± 2 nm)
- Resistivity up to 3x bulk silver
- Compatible with aerosol jettable Xerox dielectric ink (xdi-dcs)
- Customization available
- Produced at kilo-scale in XRCC pilot plant with consistent lot-to-lot reproductibility

Materials Performance

Resistivity	< 9 μΩ·cm
Conductivity	> 1 x 10 ⁵ S·cm ⁻¹

Conductive traces were printed using an Optomec Sprint system. Printed line widths of 0.5 mm with sintered pile heights of 1 μm were achieved when printed using the following conditions: 1 mm nozzle, 1 mm/sec print speed, 50 sccm sheath gas, 150 sccm atomizer gas (N₂).
